The CGA Program - The CGA (Certified Governmental Administrator) program was adopted by the Board in August of 1993 and renamed in 2012. The purpose of the certification program is to promote the highest standards in the administration of local government now and in the future through the development of a program for the preparation, induction and continuing professional development of Municipal Administrators. The program consists of the following requirements:

- Member of PAMA for 3 years
- Attendance at 3 PAMA Annual Conferences
- 100 Hours of Course Study
- ❖ Grade of 70% or better on a Competency Based Test
